The International Network for Theory of History will organize its Fifth Conference – on the topic of *History & Responsibility* – in Lisbon, Portugal, on 22–24 May 2024. Please see the Call for Papers [here](#).

The International Commission for the Theory and History of Historiography (ICHTH) wishes to host a panel at this Conference. Its topic will be “Responsible History.”

If you intend to attend this Conference and would like to be considered for inclusion in the panel, please send us an email with an attachment containing a draft abstract (300–500 words) of the points you would wish to cover in a paper. Our goal is to secure at least three contributors in addition to the Chair, and we welcome proposals from members around the world, and from scholars at all stages of career. Early career researchers are encouraged in particular to apply.

ICHTH membership is no condition for submitting an application. If we receive more applications than there are places in the panel, we will make a selection. Please note that ICHTH is unable to provide financial support. However, we intend to cooperate with an international journal in our focus area to publish our papers or a summary of our findings.
