2026 ICTH-INTH Book Prizes for the History and Theory of Historiography

The International Commission for the History and Theory of Historiography (ICTH) and the International Network for Theory of History (INTH) jointly award two prizes, worth 500 euros each, for the Best Book and Best First Book on any aspect of the history and theory of historiography.

Scope

- The Prize focuses on books in the fields of the history and theory of historiography.
- All authors, whether ICTH or INTH members or not, can submit.
- Authors may submit only one book.
- A book is any single-author publication with an ISBN. Books without ISBN, edited volumes, translations, re-editions, and unpublished Ph.D. dissertations are not accepted.
- There are two categories: the Best First Book targets first works (including published Ph.D. dissertations) of early career scholars; the Best Book targets all other works.
- The submitted book should be published between 1 January 2024 and 31 December 2025.

Submissions are now open for the 2026 ICTH–INTH BEST BOOK AND BEST FIRST BOOK
